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**VIVA ACCESS LTD**

21 y.o. boy – independent manual wheelchair user, bilateral AKAs, severe heart condition. Unable to use prosthetic limbs.

15 y.o. brother – recent diagnosis progressive condition, may be wh/chair user in future. Currently falling and difficulty on stairs.

**CASE STUDY****New Build**

Live with mum/dad and 10 y.o. sister; supportive rural community but current housing has poor access and is overcrowded.

**The OT has been asked to assess a new wheelchair standard house to see if suitable for family to move into.**

- If not, why not i.e. what difficulties might they encounter?
- Can any potential difficulties be overcome by major or minor adaptations?
- Although the approach route & parking are not shown on the drawings, what recommendations would you make nonetheless?
- How effective (or not) do you think these floor plans are as generic wheelchair housing templates?
