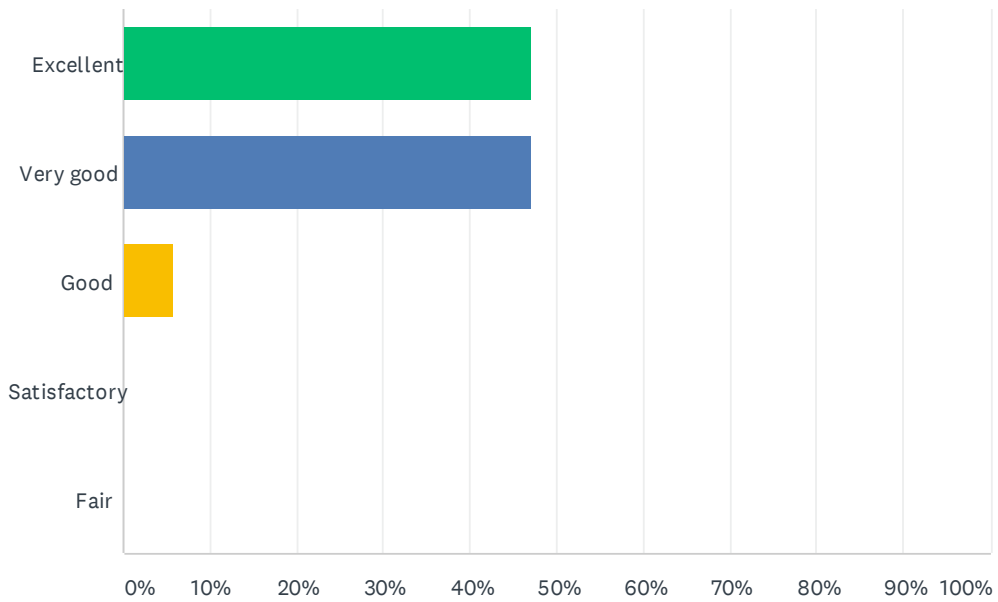


# Q1 How likely is it you would recommend this course to a colleague?

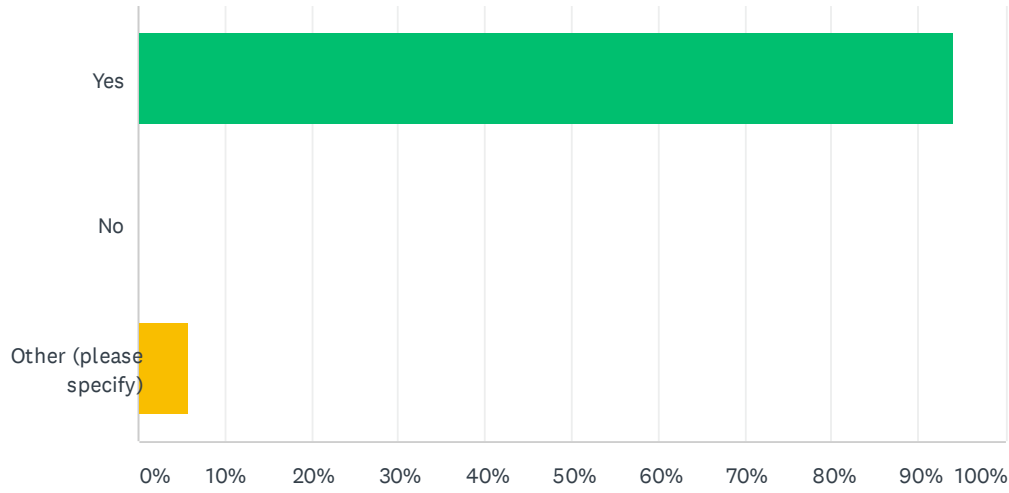

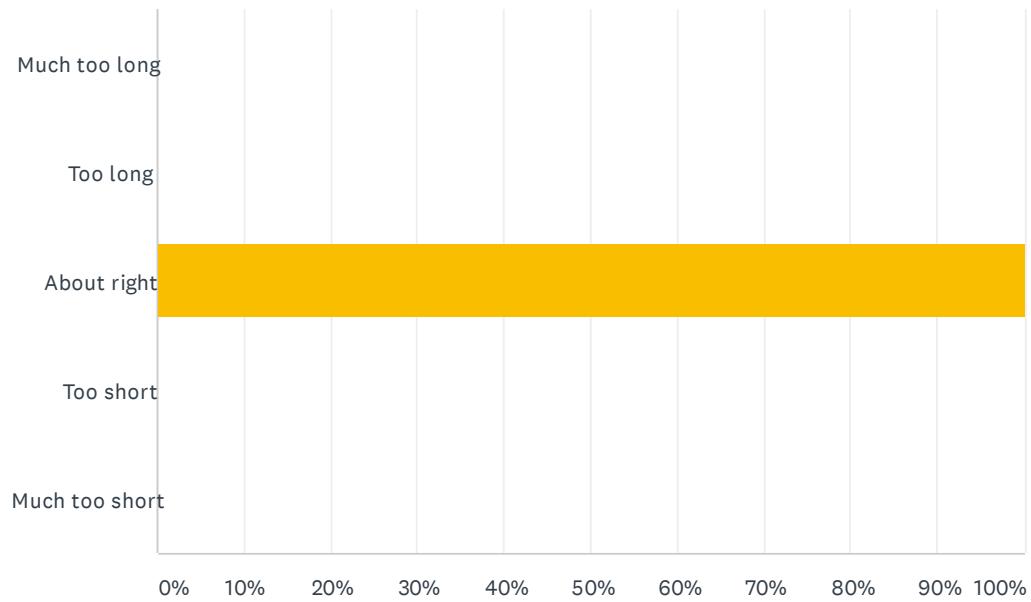

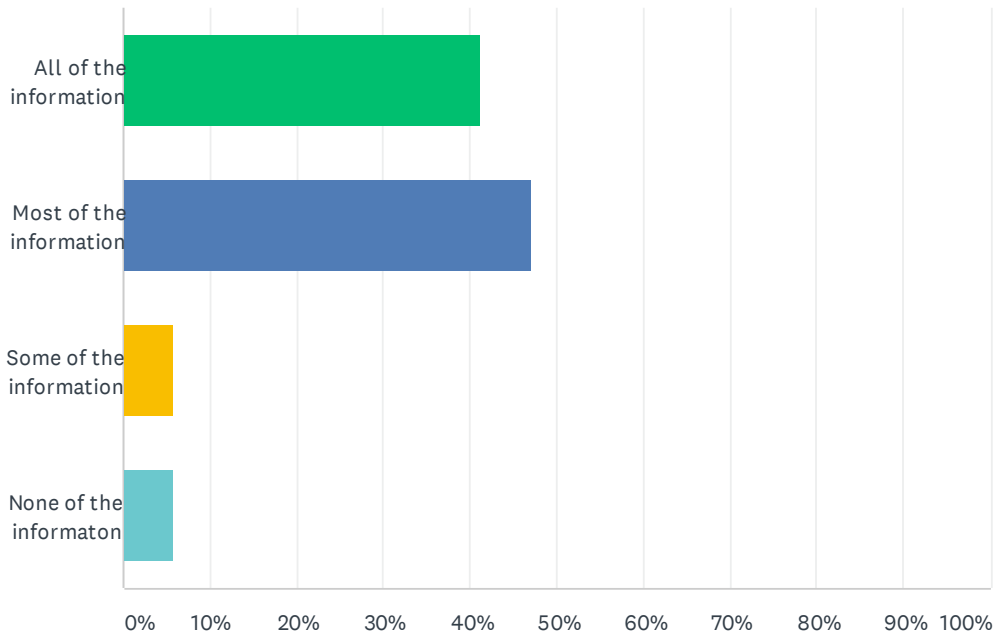

## Q4 Prior to the event, how much of the information that you needed did you get?

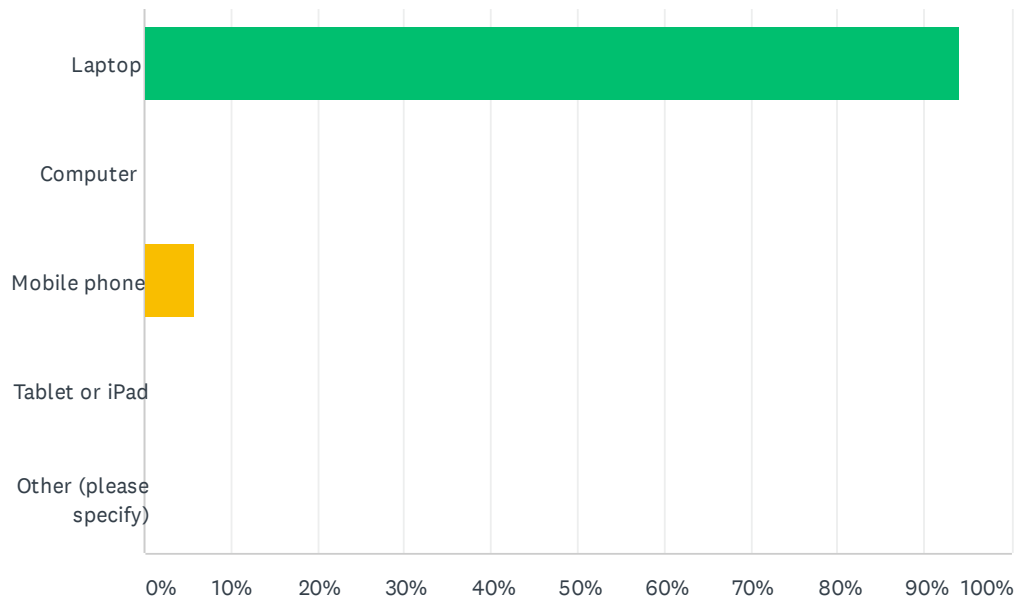

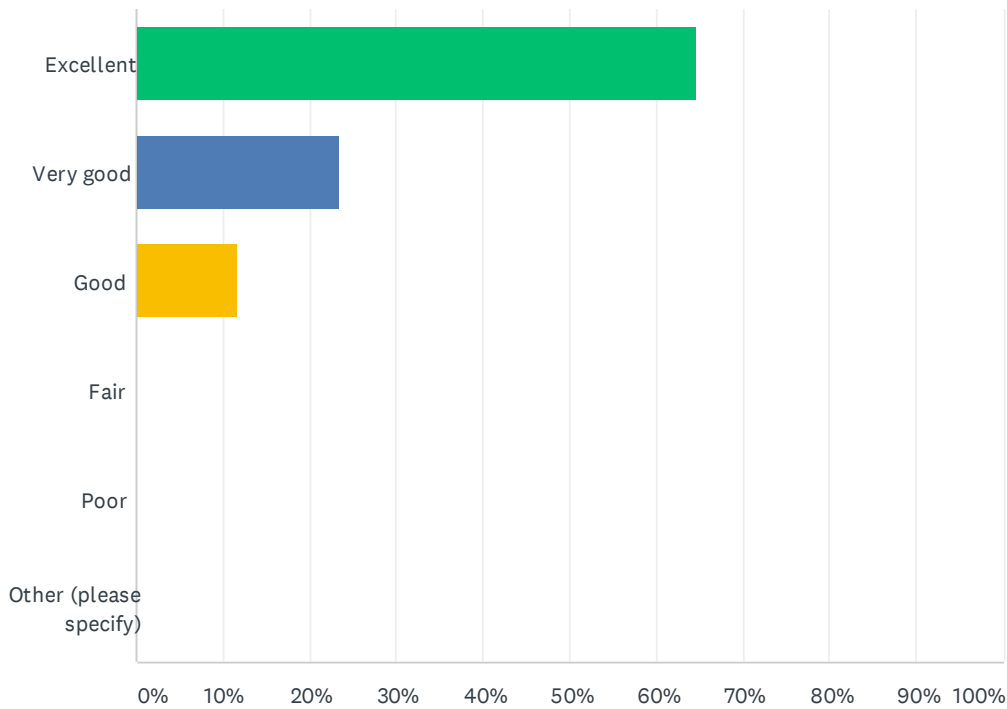

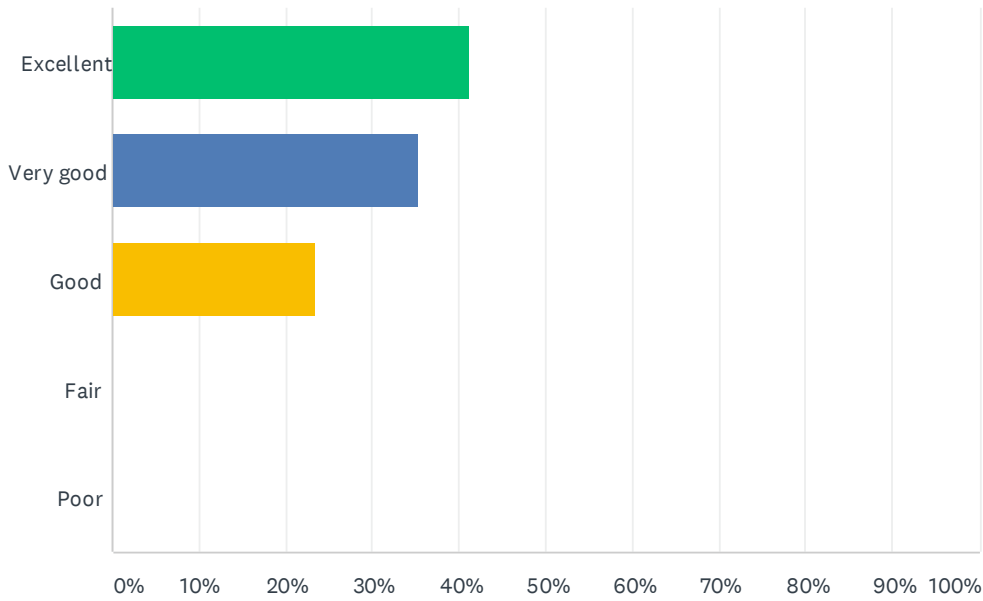
